Reflection: This Sunday is the Feast of **THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD.**

In terms of Liturgy, it serves to mark **the conclusion of the holy Christmas Season.**

There must surely be a very profound significance in this being so – after all, there was a 30-year gap between the Bethlehem stable and then Jesus at the River Jordan event.

For us, it has to be drawing the closest of connections between one's date of birth and one's date of Baptism i.e. on date of birth, one is **born into earthly life**; on date of Baptism, one is **born into eternal life.**

As the Only Begotten Son of God, Jesus did not, of course, require Baptism. We know how amazed John the Baptist was, upon looking down the line of those who awaited his mere water Baptism, to see Jesus there. (John was very quick to let one and all know that he was very much Jesus' inferior, as only Jesus could baptise with the Holy Spirit).

By humbly accepting John's mere water baptism, Jesus wished to show us how vital Baptism is for us.

The Sacrament of Baptism takes away the mark of Original Sin from the individual soul. It marks the person out for eternal happiness with God in Heaven.

Besides, on that day at the River Jordan, Jesus wished there to be **a revealing of the Blessed Trinity** – the voice of God the Father from the heavens; God the Son humbly standing in the waters; God the Holy Spirit descending in the form of a dove and resting upon His Head.

May this Feast assure us all of the greatness of Baptism, and how it unites Heaven and earth for each of us.
